THE COMPANY MAN

Robert L. “Bob” Sanders of Milwaukee, Wisconsin, died on June 22, 2016, at the age of 63.

He was born February 5, 1953, in Dayton, Ohio, the son of Juanita (nee Jenkins) and the late Jack Sanders.

A graduate of Vanderbilt University, he began his actuarial career at Allstate Insurance Company in Northbrook, Illinois. In 1979 Sanders moved to Milwaukee to join Milliman in its casualty practice, which was just a three-person office. This small office of three employees would become Sanders’ home for 36 years. He worked as a principal and consulting actuary and became nationally recognized as an expert in medical professional liability issues. Sanders helped grow Milliman into one of the largest P&C actuarial consulting practices in the U.S.

To Sanders, Milliman was family. He had a genuine interest in the professional and personal well-being of others and often mentored coworkers. He considered his clients his friends.

When not working, Sanders spent time hiking in his favorite national parks: Yellowstone, Grand Canyon, Grand Teton and Glacier. Much of his home was furnished with artwork that depicted his most beloved hiking spots. He loved music and seeing his favorite artists in concert. His album collection was extensive.

When his father died, Sanders purchased a unit in his condo for his mother so that he could more easily provide care for her. His loyalty and care for others will have a lasting impact on all those who knew him.

Sanders was the brother of David (Janet) Sanders; nephew of the late Leon and Helen Jenkins and Wanda and Ron Oates. He is survived by other relatives and friends.
